Cooked breakfast provided at motel. Today we head off early as we travel to Mogo for a visit to the wonderful Mogo Zoo. Your visit to this wonderful venue will include morning tea on arrival, tour around the zoo with guide (depending on availability) and a special opportunity to experience the giraffe feeding. Lunch today is included and taken at nearby Tomakin Sports Club. In the afternoon we make our way to the Original Gold Rush Colony Mogo. Visit includes gold history tour with gold panning, and of course a chance to wander the grounds, a faithfully re-created 1850s Gold Rush Village with buildings and exhibits collected from the NSW original South Coast goldfields. Return to accommodation at Narooma. Dinner taken onsite at motel. Accommodation: Top of the Town Motel, Narooma Ph 4476 2099

Cooked breakfast provided at motel. This morning we head south from Narooma to Central Tilba. En-route we will stop for morning tea (provided by Kiama Scenic Tours). Drop into Mystery Bay for viewing. We then go to Central Tilba to visit the Tilba Real Dairy. Cheese and honey tastings are available, as well as a chance to view cheese making, milk bottling and yoghurt making through the large glass windows. Browse Central Tilba township. Lunch during this time (at your expense). We then head back to Narooma to drop into the Visitors Centre. The centre is split into 3 sections – souvenirs/gift shop, art gallery and the Lighthouse Museum (which features the original glass and mechanics from the first lighthouse on Montague Island).

Free afternoon to browse Narooma township.  
 Return to accommodation.

 Check out from our accommodation in Narooma today.  
 This morning we will drive by the Narooma wharf then on to view Bar Rock Lookout and Australia Rock from the park on the north side of the town.  
 We then continue to head north, where will drive through the township of Moruya and on to the Historic Quarry Park, an idyllic picnic area located on the shores of the beautiful Moruya River. Kiama Scenic Tours to provide morning tea while here.  
 We then follow the coast road to Batemans Bay.  
 Once in Batemans Bay we join Merinda Cruises for a cruise up the Clyde River to Nelligen and return. Fish and chips lunch on board.  
 Head back up to the Shoalhaven and Illawarra.
