Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast provided at motel. Today we visit the spectacular Mayfield Garden at Oberon for its annual Autumn Time Festival. Mayfield is one of the world's largest privately-owned cool climate gardens. It extends across for more than 160 acres and sits within a 5000 acre working farm. There is a meticulously crafted garden centre, stunning water garden as well as a breathtaking obelisk. Upon arrival at Mayfield you will enjoy morning tea of homemade cakes & slices and tea/coffee served at the onsite Mayfield Café. We will then be joined by a guide who will hop aboard the coach as we make our way through the garden to the highest point, the chapel. The guide will then join those who would like to walk back down through the garden. For those who feel they are not up to walking back, our coach can drop you to the Sandstone Gallery, where you can then make your way to the café again. The garden mini bus shuttle will also be in operation during this period, so you may like to hop aboard this to make your way back down through the garden that our large coach cannot access. Seats on the shuttle subject to availability on the day. Lunch will then be taken back at the Mayfield Café. Your Mayfield Lunch Box includes sandwiches, garden salad, cakes & slices and tea/coffee. In the afternoon we will drive in to Oberon township for a chance for a quick walk of the town. If time permits we will also pop into Chifley Dam. Return to your accommodation. DAY 3 - Tuesday

Full Hot & Cold Buffet Breakfast provided at motel. This morning we do the loop from Bathurst to the towns of Millthorpe, Carcoar, Blayney and return. Our first stop will be Millthorpe, a heritage listed town approx. 30 minutes from Bathurst. We will enjoy a visit to the Golden Memories Museum, run and operated by the Millthorpe and District Historical Society. The society was formed in 1964 and the museum opened in 1965. During the visit you will enjoy a look around the museum as well as a wonderful Devonshire Tea!



We will then go on to Carcoar, astride the banks of the Belubula River, which lays claim to be the most intact historic village in Australia! The village has been authentically and fully restored and conserved in close consultation with the National Trust. Buildings of note include the Georgian style terrace of shops in Belubula Street, the mid-Victorian court house, the convict built stone stables, St Paul's Church and the Church of Immaculate Conception and Shalom House of Prayer and many more buildings that are redolent of another era.

After a morning of history in Millthorpe and Carcoar we make our way to Blayney, the main town of the shire, for lunch (your expense). Stroll the streets where Autumn Colour should be blooming.

After our Blayney visit we will head back to Bathurst for a quick look around. Return to your accommodation.

Dinner taken onsite at motel.
