Check out and depart our accommodation at Geelong this morning. We head north back towards Werribee, where we will visit *Werribee Park Mansion* for a self-guided tour. The mansion is made from basalt and sandstone and was completed in 1877 for the Chirnside family who were originally from Scotland, and made their fortune from wool across the Western District of Victoria. Light morning tea provide by Kiama Scenic Tours during the visit.

It is then on to Melbourne where we will visit the historic *Queen Victoria Market*, Melbourne's iconic marketplace. Officially opened in 1878, the market has been serving the people of Melbourne for more than 140 years. The markets has seen many transformations and was added to the national heritage list in recognition of its links to the early colonial population of Melbourne. An historic landmark spread over two city blocks, it's a vibrant and bustling inner-city market where you can shop at over 600 small businesses for everything from Australian fruit and veg, local and imported gourmet food, clothing and souvenirs. Our visit today will allow you time to browse as well as grab your lunch (own expense).

On board again after lunch, we express to *Albury* for the final night of our tour, staying at the Quality Inn Resort Siesta.
